This course provides a forum for Sports Medicine Specialists to discuss problems and concepts related to preventing, treating and rehabilitating injured athletes. The Symposium topics will include: general sports medicine, head and cervical spine injury, foot and ankle, the adolescent athlete, upper extremity, lower extremity biomechanics and rehabilitation, and the knee. In addition, there will be special workshops on cutting-edge topics: Biomechanics and the Principles of Rehabilitation, Cardiac Screening and Sports Medicine. This year's anatomy dissection demonstrations focus on the Shoulder and the Elbow and Hand.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The 44th Annual Symposium on Sports Medicine is designed for orthopedic surgeons, physicians, physician assistants, physical therapists, nurses, athletic trainers and coaches.
